RESPONSIBILITIES OF VISITING DANCE TEACHER

It is expected that JASSPA Dance teachers will:

- Work closely with the Director and other Jasspa dance teachers
- Run punctual, well structured classes each lasting 40/50/60mins
- Monitor students' attendance, progress and enjoyment
- Prepare classes for annual shows in our on-site purpose built theatre. Performances should exhibit pupil enjoyment and technical / creative skills appropriate to the level of class
- Encourage appropriate dance-wear including hair tied back
- Encourage regular attendance and best dancing by inspiring their pupils during lesson time
- Welcome parents to end of term Open Days
- Encourage pupils to work through exercises/routines at home mid-week prior to shows
- Be aware of JASSPA's Health and Safety policy located in our hand book
- Be aware of individual pupil special needs/medical conditions
