Where is Leicester?



Leicester is a city in England.

It is in the East Midlands which is right in the middle of England.

What is the Attenborough Arts Centre?



The Attenborough Arts Centre is a small venue for performances, art exhibition and creative classes.

It is inclusive and does a lot of work that supports disabled people.

The building is fully accessible.

Getting to Attenborough Arts Centre by Bus



There are two bus stations in Leicester.

This is Leicester St Margaret's Bus Station. It is 10 minutes from our location.



This is Leicester Haymarket Bus Station

Bus routes 47 and 48 leave from this station to get to Attenborough Arts Centre.

Getting to Attenborough Arts Centre by Train



This is Leicester Train station.

Leicester is on the London to Sheffield and the Birmingham to Stansted lines.



It will take 12 minutes to walk from the station to the Attenborough Arts Centre.



The number 48 bus goes from the station to the Attenborough Arts Centre.

This bus is travelling to Wigston Magna.



Go to Stand ED on Station Street outside the station.

You will travel for 3 stops and get off on Regent Road.

The Attenborough Arts Centre is 3 minute walk from this bus stop.
