What is the day about?

You will meet other dancers, talk to people, think about your own dance career, and take part in a dance workshop.

You might be asked questions about how you feel about dancing, and what things you would like to do in the future.



Why are we doing it?

We want to find out how people become dance leaders with a learning disability and how they can develop leadership qualities.

We want to talk about how we can work together to make sure the voices of dance leaders with a learning disability can be heard.



What will the day feel like?

Although some of the subjects are serious, we want it to be a fun day and a chance for you to express your skills and creativity.

There will be about 70 people there on the day, so it may feel busy and noisy at times.



Do I need to bring my lunch?

No. Tea, coffee and lunch are included in the ticket price. Please bring a water bottle that you can use through the day.



What do I need to wear?

Wear something loose and comfortable that you can dance in.

Wear comfortable shoes that you can move in.

Bring some layers such as a hoodie or joggers.



What do I need to bring?

Bring a refillable water bottle and a notepad and pen.

Bring any medications you may need to take.



Where will it take place?

It will take place in Attenborough Arts Centre in Leicester.

Leicester is a city in England.

It is in the East Midlands which is right in the middle of England.



The building is fully accessible.

This is the Main Hall is where you will spend some of the day.

There are also breakout rooms we will be using on the day.




This is the café in Attenborough Arts Centre.
